Got old, torn, faded flags?

Flags that are no longer in a condition to be flown should not be thrown away as trash. They should be retired honorably. If you have a flag that is torn, tattered, or faded, you may deposit in is the special box in front of Post 38 (Veterans Lane, between Euclid and Redman Avenues) or take it to the Fire House (Haddon Avenue). From time to time, Post 38 conducts a flag retirement ceremony during which unserviceable flags are burned.
